Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation: An Effective System (Point)

"What I fear,
I forget What I see,
I remember What I do".
I understand Education shapes a man's future. Is education just reading or writing by rote alone? I firmly believe that education has a wide spectrum of meaning and cannot be restricted to learning with the help of pen and paper alone. Academic performance must recognize and encourage special ability of students those who are not academically inclined but may excel in other co-curricular activities.

That is where continuous and comprehensive evaluation (CCE) plays an important role. CCE may have disturbed the old set norms but human race is never open to change. CCE is a positive step towards educational reforms and shall overcome all the resistance after initial hiccups.

One major criticism against CCE is that it curbs the student's ability to excel since grading systems has been implemented. Personally, I believe that those students who have set their goals and work towards it, grades or marks do not make any difference.

CCE provides a balming touch and treats the students with compassion.

CCE also encourages parents especially, in primary and middle levels to get involved in their wards life in a very positive way. Activity based learning and evaluation process involves parents' contributions as well. This indeed is a very positive change. Different kinds of activities provide different experiences to all kinds of personalities and makes them confident human being. The parents are expected to encourage their children to learn more about the subject through different reference books, internet facilities etc. this system demands the teachers to be more diligent, objective and far more humane in their approach towards their students. CCE discourages cramming and relieves the students and the parents of the examination blues. For any system to work effectively total involvement of school management, teacher and parents is mandatory, CCE is here to stay and we need to find a way to implement it in an effective manner.

CCE (Comprehensive Continuous Evaluation) is a system which has been introduced in the recent past by the central Board of Education to evaluate overall personality of the student. I do believe, that it takes a little while for any system to get rooted, to establish itself and to get accepted.

Every system has to be analyzed thread bear before it gets implemented, for no system is ever fool - proof.

As a teacher my main aim is to facilitate learning. However CCE as a system of evaluation demands a lot of time. It is indeed a labourious process. I strongly believe that for a system to be successful, it should be less complicated and far simpler. In my opinion though it is the moral duty of the parents to keep a check on the progress of their wards and most of them do take keen interest, however, there are many parents who complain of time constraints. CCE demands the parents to be fully involved in the academics, in their project work and in all kinds of extra curricular activities. It is not very practical to implement unless the teachers take special interest and care of the students and offer some remedial measures. This may prove beneficial for the welfare of the students.

Under the CCE, the system of grades puts a student who has scored 90% vis - a - vis a student who scored 99%. This may not be very fair to those students who have worked very hard to achieve their goals. CCE on its own merit is a very commendable step. However, in the implementation of it as teachers we need to be very cautious in not losing the very purpose of education. i.e. 'The pursuit of excellence'. I feel CCE as system may encourage morally weak students or miscreants to pressurize the teachers to alter the grades and may further degrade the character of the students. Infact one very glaring change which has come to the fore after the implementation of CCE is that the 10th Std. students have taken the board Exam very lightly and have stopped putting in hard work.

Finally, I would like to summit by saying that CCE is indeed a positive step towards reducing the burden of the students however as teachers we need to study it in depth and should implement it in all its fairness.

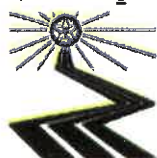
